

FCCLA Planning Process



IDENTIFY CONCERNS

I chose to focus on my local Ronald McDonald House for this project because I was concerned that they didn't receive enough money to completely help all of the families staying there. This is because Ronald McDonald Houses make most of their income through donations and grants, leaving the actual McDonalds franchise to only pay each house approximately \$8,500 a year.

SET A GOAL



My main goal was to fundraise enough soda can tabs to help support the Ronald McDonald house, therefore it can easily provide basic hygiene and household items to the families staying there.

FORM A PLAN (WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE, HOW, COST, RESOURCES, AND EVALUATION)



Who: The students and staff at Bonaire Middle School, and those staying/working at the Macon, GA Ronald McDonald house.

<u>What:</u> Fundraising soda can tabs to donate to a Ronald McDonald house so they have more money to put towards food and other items.

Where: Bonaire Middle School, and the Macon, GA Ronald McDonald House (located by the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit)

When: October 1, 2019 - October 31, 2019, December 4, 2019

How: I researched how much each Ronald McDonald House made annually then decided to help the nearest Ronald McDonald house. I created posters and had several announcements made. Then the fundraising started. After a month, the homeroom that collected the most tabs, weightwise, received an ice cream sandwich party.

Cost: The only item I needed to purchase for this project were ice cream sandwiches, which were \$10.

Resources: I used BMS FCCLA's social media pages (Instagram and Facebook) to help promote this fundraiser.

ACT

August - September: I chose the idea of raising soda can tabs.

September: I created posters and made announcements about the fundraiser. October: I collected tabs the entire month.
